Dear all,

I regret to inform you that three more cases have been reported in Grade 10 in the past 24 hours. Given the surge in cases in the grade and in the absence of a response from the local health authorities (ASL RM 1), our Medical Director, Dr. Andrea Guerriero, has recommended putting the **entire grade online until the 21st January 2022 (included)**, with re-entry on the 24th January.

Please note that while **all the students in the grade will be online until the 21st**, the health measures required by the law are differentiated according to the vaccination or recovery status as per Minister for Health guidelines of 30.12.2022:

- a. Students who received their booster dose or have been fully vaccinated from less than 120 days or recovered from Covid-19 from less than 120 days: Autosorveglianza (required to wear FFP2 for 10 days since the last contact and monitor their symptoms for 5-10 days and if show any symptoms take immediately a covid 19 swab test).
As a precautionary measure, we still advise testing on the 18th January 2022 (antigen rapid test or PCR molecular test)
- b. Students who are vaccinated (full vaccination cycle) from more than 120 days or recovered from Covid 19 from more than 120 days, will need to perform a covid 19 test (antigen rapid test or PCR molecular Test) on the **18th January** and, if negative, end their quarantine
- c. Students who are not vaccinated will need to continue to quarantine and perform an antigen rapid test or PCR molecular test on the **23rd of January**, and, if negative, end their quarantine period.

The last contact has been determined to be on the 13th of January. Students who were absent on the 10th, 11th, 12th, and 13th will follow classes online but no quarantine/testing measures apply.

All students will be readmitted to school on the 24th, provided they have done the required test on the date specified in this email. Otherwise, a recent negative test (48 hours) will be required.
